DECISION

of 6 March 2017, concerning the extension of the deadline for presenting candidatures laid down in the Resolution of 3 February 2017, by the Director of the Catalan Data Protection Authority, approving the rules and regulations for the Protection of Data by Design Award and launching the call for proposals for the 2017 prize.

In view of Resolution of 3 February 2017, approving the rules and regulations for the Protection of Data by Design Award and launching the call for proposals for the 2017 prize (DOGC -Official Journal of the Government of Catalonia- number 7309, of 15.2.2017);

Considering that article 3.2 of the Resolution 3 February 2017, approving the rules and regulations for the Protection of Data by Design Award and launching the call for proposals for the 2017 prize, provides that the period for presenting candidatures is established as one month, beginning the day after publication of this Resolution in the DOGC

Due to the complexity to prepare the required documentation for presenting candidatures, especially taking into account that some of the applications may still be under development, and in order to secure the greatest possible participation in this call for proposals, this Authority considers appropriate to extend the deadline for presenting candidatures, in accordance with provisions laid down in the article 32.1 of Law 39/2015, of October 1, on the Common Administrative Procedure of public Administrations:

Therefore, in accordance with the duties assigned to me under the provisions of Law 32/2010, of October 1, on the Catalan Data Protection Authority,

I hereby resolve:

- 1. To extend the period for submission of applications provided for in the article 3.2 of the Resolution 3 February 2017, approving the rules and regulations for the Protection of Data by Design Award and launching the call for proposals for the 2016 prize, to 24 March 2017.
- 2. To publish this Resolution in the Official Journal of the Government of Catalonia

In accordance with article 32.3 of Law 39/2015, this resolution on extending the period for submission of applications is not subject to appeal.
